A motion was made by Linda and seconded by Pam to approve the December 10, 2018 meeting minutes. Motion approved.

NEW BUSINESS:

Tiffany gave a review of the most recent Village Board meeting. The Village board has voted to not purchase the BMO Bank building. They voted to have the Building Committee look at remodeling/adding on to the present Library building.

Paul Bauer explained two options for the Library facility. Option 1 would be accomplished in 4 phases:

Phase 1-Build an approximately 5,000 square foot addition on the back of the current Library.

Phase 2-Remodel current Library space.

Phase 3-Build a Library green space to the west of new addition.

Phase 4-Remodel the lower level (Senior Center)

Option 2 would lease land across Main Street from present Library with the idea that the Library would lease space from a multi-use building that would be built there.

Discussion followed on these options. Time to complete each of these options was a concern. It was decided to pursue Option 1-phases 1 and 2 at this time.

A motion was made by Linda and seconded by Pam to send a draft RFP to the Library Board for their approval at their July meeting. With their approval, architects will be contacted and asked to come up with a design to not exceed 2 million dollars..

A motion was made by Jeanette and seconded by Jeanne to adjourn the meeting.
