## Minutes from Library Building Executive Committee meeting 6/8/2020

- The thought is that the BMO Bank building could be bought for about \$350,000.
- Could spend \$250,000 to \$300,000 to remodel the bank building. Remodeling would be putting a ramp between main lobby and addition to the East. Remove the wall between the lobby and East addition. Replace the roof. Vary basic remodeling.
- Only the upstairs will be used to start with.
- The Library Building Committee will continue to do fund raising to do more extensive remodeling of the library portion
- Remodeling of the basement for Senior Center could be done later and paid for with grants.
- Up to the Village to decide when to remodel basement.
- If the Village contributed \$500,000 more remodeling can be done.
- The building committee is not talking phases of remodeling the current Library building.
- Current building is lacking green space.
- Remodeling current building will greatly reduce parking.
- While remodeling current building, Library will need to be moved to a temporary location.
- Fund raising at stand still due to virus.
